Fabric suggestions: Tweed, woolens, lightweight denim, linen, crepe, Dupioni silk.

Notions: Thread, desired number of buttons (see pattern instructions), 1/4 or 1 yard interfacing***, shoulder pads (optional).

Notes: *

5/8" seam allowed.

* This pattern was designed to fit a modern (non-corseted) bustline. If you do plan to wear a corset, take your measurements while wearing your corset and be sure to fit your lining toile over your corseted form.

** The pattern pieces included in this envelope go from size 6 to size 18 only; no more sizes would fit on the sheet. If you are over a size 18, you can size this pattern up, using my instructions at sensibility.com/pattern/resizepattern.htm. Sizes 20-26 are included on this chart so that you will have the required yardage for those sizes.

*** You will need only 1/4 yard of interfacing if you face the collar alone; you'll need 1 yard if you face the collar and the jacket front. (See instructions.)
