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Yardage Requirement for Sleeveless Pelisse:

[NOTE: The amount given below is for the bodice ONLY. You will need to determine how long you wish to make your skirt and purchase enough material for it. See pattern instructions for details.]

Yardage Requirement for "DD" Ladies: Because there is an extra side panel for the 18-26DD pattern, you'll need to add 1/4 yard to any of the amounts given above (for either 45" or 54"-wide material). There are supplemental instructions for the "DD" bodice at the end of the instruction booklet.

Yardage Requirement for Making a Coat (Pelisse with Sleeves): See pattern instructions to help determine amount of fabric needed for coat "skirt."

Fabric suggestions: Wool, linen, silk, velvet, heavier cottons, lightweight brushed denim. Sleeveless pelisses can also be made sheer of voile or organdy if you omit the lining and flat-fell your seams to keep them pretty. Lining for faced jacket can be silk or 100% cotton.

Notions: Thread, four buttons for double-breasted jacket or "DD" jacket, frog closures or clasps for non-overlapping jacket or sleeveless pelisse (number of frogs or clasps is according to personal preference). Note that you can also omit buttons and have the overlapping jacket or pelisse close with hidden hooks and eyes--very common for this time period.

Notes: **5/8" seam allowed except where noted on pattern pieces.**
